Bin Theft and Arson

Whilst out and about in the above areas, I noticed that there are a lot of bins left out on the public highway and footpaths when it is not your collection day.

You may be aware that there have been a spate of wheelie bin thefts and fires in your areas and because of this, it is extremely important that you only present your bins on collection day and return it to your property boundary as soon as possible after collection.

If your bin is stolen and set alight, these fires cause damage to the bin, the area around it and properties. If your black bin were to go missing, be stolen or set alight, there is a charge for a new black bin of £36.

Bins that are left out also cause an obstruction to other pedestrians, wheelchair users or families with pushchairs. They make the street look untidy and uncared which can attract fly-tipping and vermin.

Please only present your bins by **7am** on your collection day and **return** it to your property boundary as soon as you can after it has been emptied.

If this letter does not apply to you, please ignore it and accept our apologies for any inconvenience caused and thank you for continuing to store your bins within your property boundary.
