Welcome to our mid-year update on the work of the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside.

(All figures provided cover North Lincolnshire specifically unless stated otherwise).

COMMUNITY SAFETY FUND

- Almost £21,000 invested into 6 projects.
- Over 360 people involved.

CHILD AND ADULT SAFEGUARDING

Almost £15,500 committed.

VIOLENCE PREVENTION PARTNERSHIP (HUMBER-WIDE)

- Over £146,000 spent on interventions Humber-wide.
- More than £24,500 of this spent on high-impact activity.
- 3,390 young people reached (1,800 of these thorough high-impact activities).
- 29 professionals trained.

VICTIMS

- Almost 1,400 victims referred to and **supported** by victim support (North Lincolnshire).
- 630 victims (Humber-wide) were better able to cope and move forward.
- 106 new victim referrals into Blue Door for domestic abuse and sexual violence support (North Lincolnshire).

COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP

- Almost £91,000 invested to support Police and Crime Plan Delivery.
- Additional £31,000 for projects including night-time economy, Violence Against Women and Girls, and Domestic Abuse.

COMMUNITY RESPONSE FUND

- Over £67,000 invested Humber-wide into 7 projects.
- Around 200 people involved in 233 activities Humber-wide.
- Over 40 participants and more than 21 support sessions in North Lincolnshire.
- £7,035 for Hull KR Foundation Get Inspired Winterton multi-sports activities.
- £10,000 for Winterton Rocks music-based outreach project.

999/101 CONTACT (HUMBER-WIDE)

- 999 emergency calls almost 100,000 calls answered in around 7 seconds on average and less than 0.2% abandoned.
- 101 non-emergency calls over 162,000 calls answered in around 2 1/2 minutes on average and around 5% abandoned.

Almost £15 million of external funding received (between May 2021-September 2023) from external grant funding, drug confiscation, property disposal, and match funding.

FORCE PERFORMANCE


- Force rated outstanding in most areas in National Inspection Report.
