How to Stay Safe and Protect Your Home

- ◆ Never give sparklers to a child under five.
- ◆ When you are watching fireworks always stand well back.
- ◆ Fireworks will scare your pets, so keep them safely indoors.
- ◆ Only adults should light and hold fireworks.
- ◆ Never go near a firework when it has been lit. Even if it hasn't gone off as it could still explode.
- ◆ If you are given a sparkler, always wear gloves and hold it at arm's length.
- ◆ When a sparkler goes out DON'T TOUCH IT. It could still burn you, so put it in a bucket of water hot end down.
- ◆ You have to be 18 years old before you are allowed to buy fireworks in the shop.
- ◆ Never play with fireworks.
